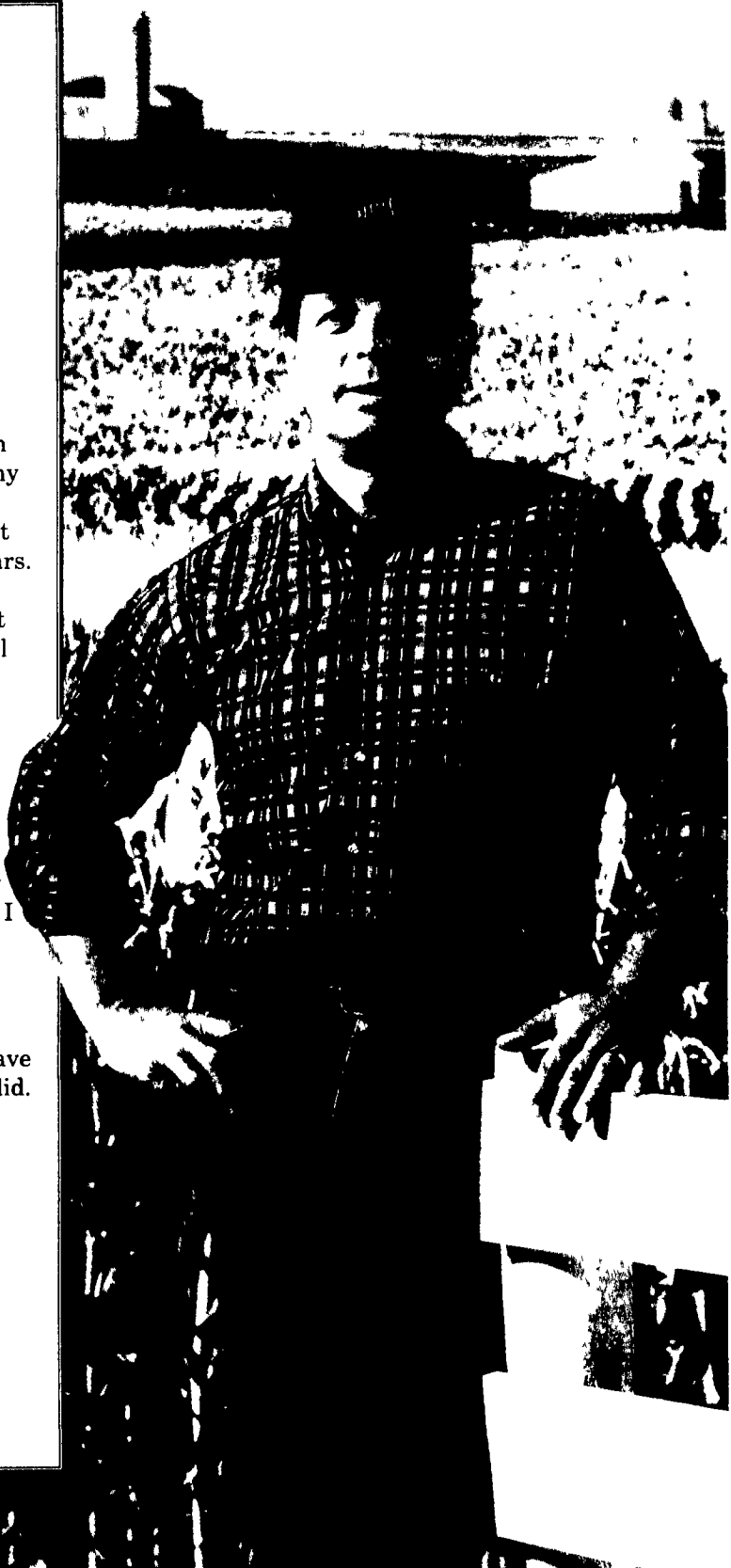
That made me wonder if I really needed to do my own testing — but I like the extra level of confidence it gives me.
