SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER. COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA

WERE STEADY TO \$5.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 7 POUNDS

HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO. LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN, \$2.50 TO \$4.50 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 4% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 3% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.


