WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW: AUGUST 22-28, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$6.25 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$4.00 TO \$7.00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA NOT TESTED, AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00 TO \$2.00 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$5.50 HIGHER, AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER.

BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 1% HIGHER THAN A WEEK AGO AND 4% HIGHER THAN A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 13 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$7.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$4.00 HIGHER.

LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 3% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00 TO \$2.25 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE \$1.00 TO \$2.50 HIGHER, EXCEPT LOINS WHICH WERE \$11.00 TO \$12.00 LOWER. 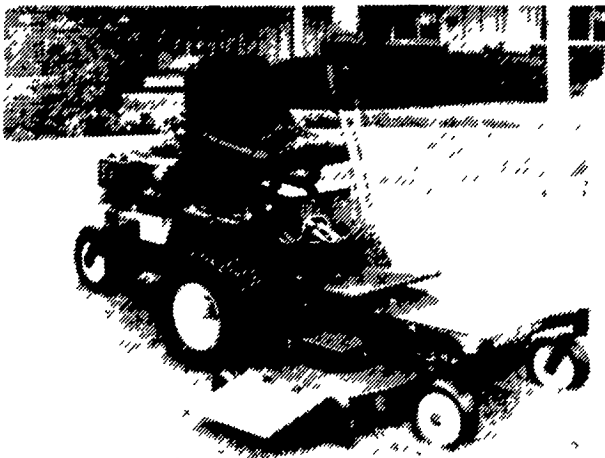

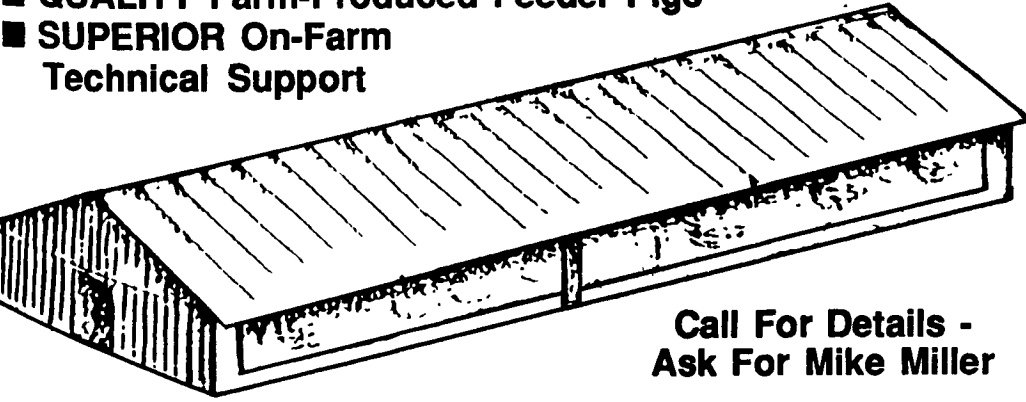
