ALLENTOWN (Lehigh Co.) -The Lehigh County Agricultural Land Preservation Board is now accepting applications for the second 1991 funding round of the Lehigh County Aricultural Conservation Easement Program.

Through this program, qualified Lehigh County farmland owners can apply to sell their development rights to the commonwealth and county. Agricultural conservation easements are placed on the land, perpetually protecting the land from nonfarm development.

To date, Lehigh County has received state approval for the preservation of three farms totaling 427 acres. Eight county landowners have accepted conservation easement purchase offers from the Lehigh County Agricultural Land Preservation Board ranging from \$1,700 to \$3,400 per acre.


