

WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW: SEPTEMBER 5-11, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00 TO \$4.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.75 TO \$7.25 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY, AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO WEAK, AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00 TO \$3.00 HIGHER.

BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 12% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 13 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$.75 TO \$1.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.50 HIGHER.

LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 5% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT UNCHANGED FROM A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00 TO \$1.75 HIGHER.

FRESH PORK PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$5.00 HIGHER.

HOG PRODUCTION WAS 13% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 6% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.
