

Solanco Fair Colored Breed Champions Named

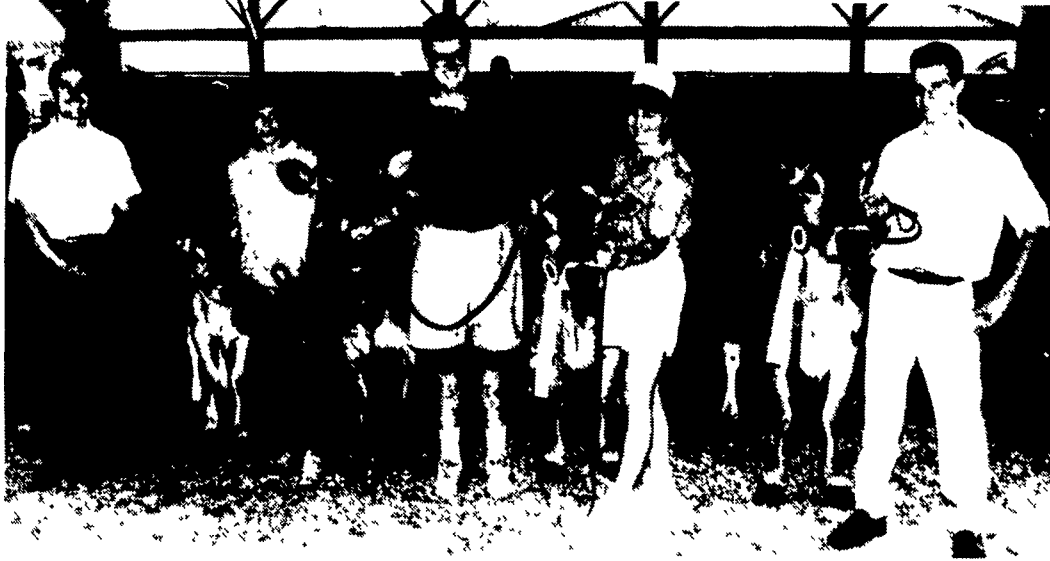
