MARKETS IN REVIEW: SEPTEM-BER 12-18, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADT TO \$3.50 LOWER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$.25 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$.50 LOWER.

BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 12% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 3% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 21 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 17% HIGHER THAN A WEEK AGO BUT 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.
