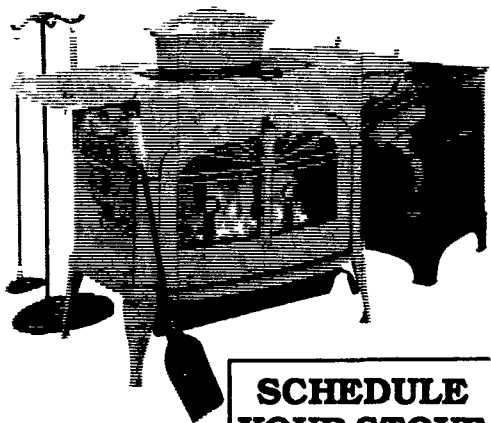

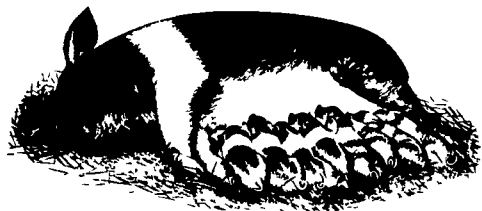

## Eastern National Holstein Sale Totals \$271,000

VERNON ACHENBACH JR., Lancaster Farming Staff HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — Buyers at the Eastern National Holstein Sale held Wednesday at the Pennsylvania Farm Show complex paid an average of \$5,416 per animal for the 50 animals put on the sale block.

The annual sale, representing some of the top pedigreed Holsteins along the East Coast, and some elsewhere, not only serves as a venue for trading top breeding stock, but also provides a gauge for local breeders by which to set their prices on private sales.

Although a list of buyers was not available by presstime, officials who organized the sale — William Nichol with the Pennsylvania Holstein Association and

David Rama with The Cattle Exchange — said the animals sold went to buyers representing at least 10 states and Canada.

Consignments came from 15 states including New York, Pennsylvania, Vermont, Virginia, Connecticut, New Mexico, Michigan, Maryland, Massachusetts, Illinois, Indiana, North Carolina, Minnesota, California, and Maine.

The top selling animal sold for \$29,000. It was the third animal offered for sale and was consigned by Dennis Yousey, of Cazenovia, N.Y. Born Jan. 28, 1990, "Conant-Acres BS Silver-ET," is a Blackstar daughter of Conant-Acres-JY Sweetness-ET, a Very Good 89 at 3 years and a 2-year-old, 365-day

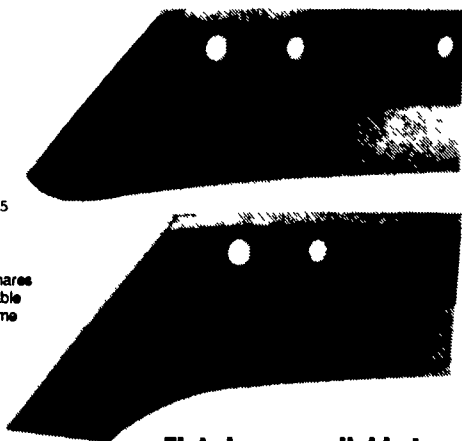

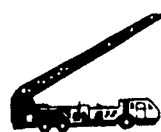
