HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — Buyers at the Eastern National Holstein Sale held Wednesday at the Pennsylvania Farm Show complex paid an average of \$5,416 per animal for the 50 animals put on the sale block.

The annual sale, representing some of the top pedigreed Holsteins along the East Coast, and some elsewhere, not only serves as a venue for trading top breeding stock, but also provides a guage for local breeders by which to set their prices on private sales.

Although a list of buyers was not available by presstime, officials who organized the sale — William Nichol with the Pennsylvania Holstein Association and


David Rama with The Cattle Exchange — said the animals sold went to buyers representing at least 10 states and Canada.


