Plan To Get Beef To Japan Widens

TOWSON, Md. - Five Baltimore County farmers are conducting a feed experiment that they hope will develop into exports of beef to Japan.

County Executive Roger Hayden met with the farmers, on the farm of Richard Price, Phoenix, Md., to thank them for their participation.

The Baltimore County Economic Development Commission (EDC) worked with J.W. Trueth & Son, a meat packing plant in Oella, Md., on a plan to get Baltimore County beef into the international market.

Trueth, which slaughters about 20,000 head of cattle annually, serves a prime restaurant trade in

Baltimore, Philadelphia, and New York City. The packer would like a prime meat that could be exported to the Japanese.

With the aid of Scott Barao, a University of Maryland agriculturalist, a feeding program was developed using Tend-R-Leen, a high protein feed from Southern States Cooperative.

"This may seem like a small program to some, but it's a great step forward for a metropolitan county like Baltimore, which is only 20 minutes from the Inner Harbor," said Lloyd Reynolds,


