Maryland Holstein Futurity Deadline Nears

CHESTERTOWN, Md. — The deadline for signup for the 1994 Maryland Holstein Futurity is Oct. 31. The event is open to all Holstein breeders in the Old Line State.

The estimated total prize money is \$4,730 with purse awards ranging from \$800 for first place to \$30 for 30th place.

Additionally, \$260 is to be divided and awarded to those first five "wins" shown in the 3-yearold futurity class, based on production. Only official DHIA or DHIR reports will be used and they must accompany the animals.

The event, number 11, is sponsored and governed by the Maryland Holstein Futurity Committee of the Maryland Holstein Association.

Those wishing to participate

need to submit pedigree information on female calves born from September 1990 to August 31, 1991. Application must be made on an official entry form available through the Maryland Holstein Association, but there is no restriction on the number of entries.

According to the entry form rules, the purpose of the futurity is to "... stimulate interest in the breeding and exhibiting of outstanding registered Hoslteins in Maryland. It recognizes the accomplishments of the small and

4-H boy or girl."

The futurity class has been held in conjunction with the Maryland State Fair and tentative plans are for that to continue. The show typically has been held on the Sunday before Labor Day in any given year. In 1994, that would be August 28.

For an animal to remain in the contest, all four payments (nominations) must be made on time. The first payment, due Oct. 31, is \$2.50 per animal. Consecutive

the large breeder and the FFA and payments are \$3 by July 31, 1992: \$6 due by April 31, 1993; and a final payment of \$10 due by Jan. 31, 1994.

If, during the course of the three years prior to the show, an owner of a nominated animal decides to sell the animal, the new owner can retain eligibility of the animal in

the futurity, as long as the futurity committee is made aware of the change in ownership and the payments are made according to schedule.


