

Landis's Sale Lamb Is Overall Grand At Manheim

MANHEIM (Lancaster Co.) — Wendall Landis showed the overall grand champion market lamb at the Manheim Farm Show sheep show Thursday night, edging out Travis Donough who showed the supreme champion market hog and steer of the show.

Landis's heavyweight sale lamb — a market lamb that was put up for sale Friday night — captured judge Ron Miller's eye over Donough's sale lamb, although Miller praised both lambs for their quality.

Miller, manager of Wey Farm, Kutztown, said, "I've seen good sheep both years I've been judge here. The (overall market lamb) champion is easily the champion sale lamb (Landis's lamb). I pick the reserve champion sale lamb as the (overall) reserve champion. Both these lambs are impressive in total pounds finish and pounds of meat they'll yield."

Among the breeding sheep show, Regina Landis's Shropshire ewe lamb was named supreme breeding animal over all seven breeds represented and both the rams and ewes.

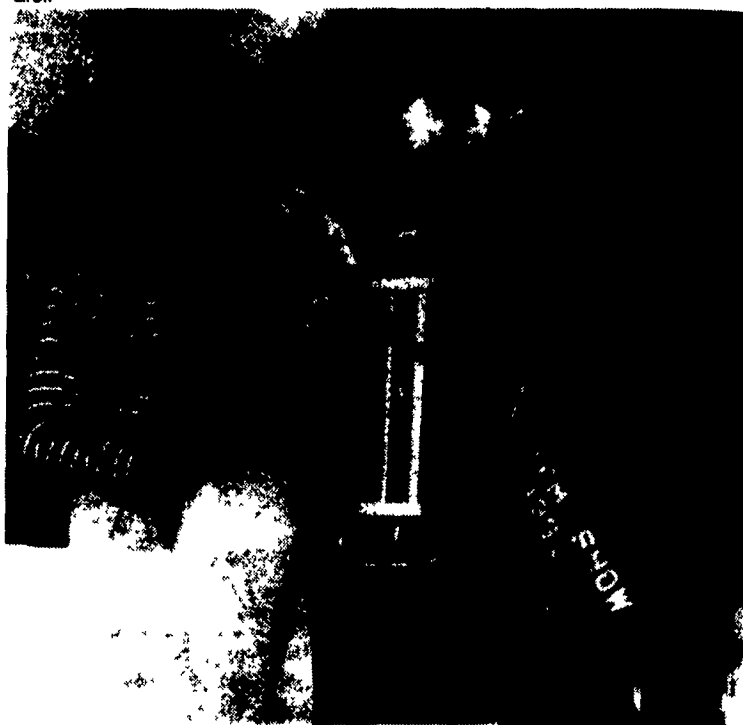

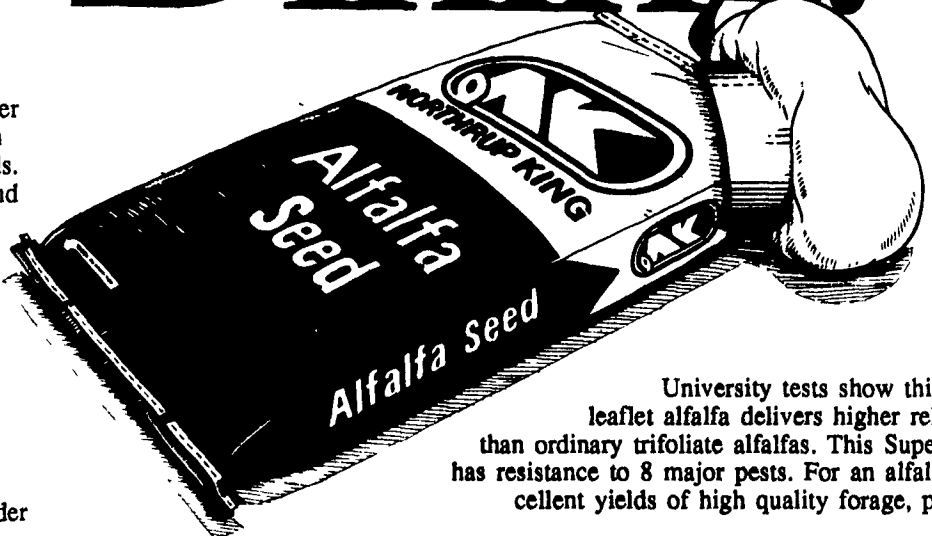
