Consider Field Or Contour Strips

LEESPORT (Berks Co.) — "With corn silage coming off and grain harvest in progress, now is the time to consider putting in field or contour strips," said Randy McCormack, district conservationist with the USDA Soil Conservation Service in Berks County.

"Producers enrolled in any USDA programs with Farm Bill plans calling for stripcropping are

encouraged to review their plans and contact the Soil Conservation Service for strip layout," he said.

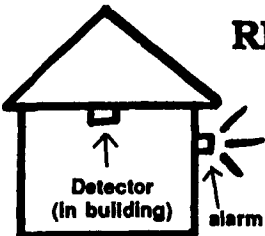
"In order for a producer to maintain eligibility for future USDA programs, he must apply all his conservation practices on his FSA plans by January 1, 1995," said McCormack.

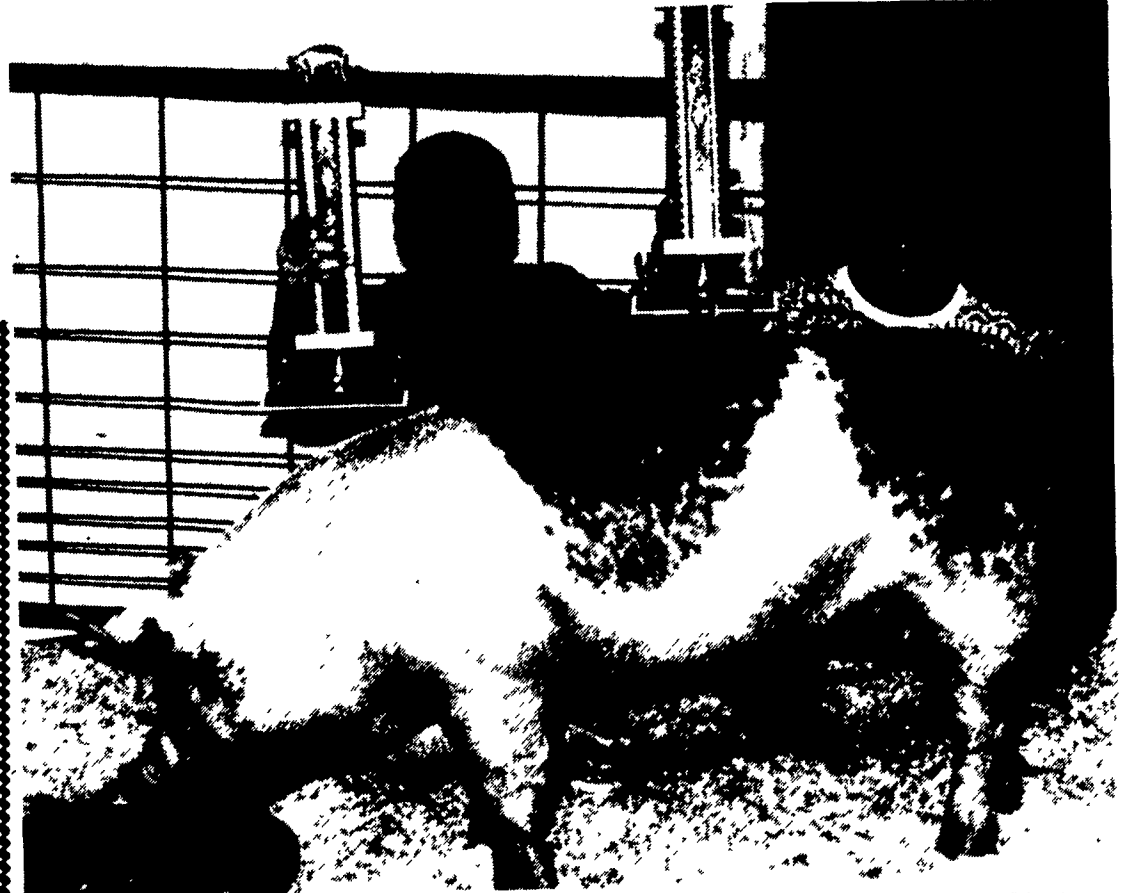

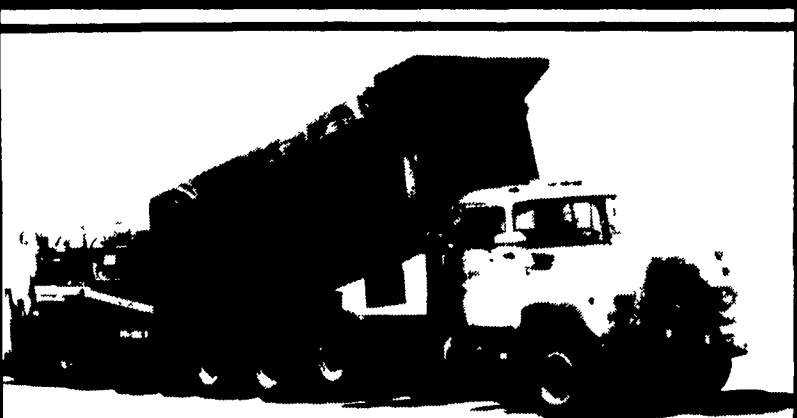
