Star award for outstanding work and for obtaining six new members.

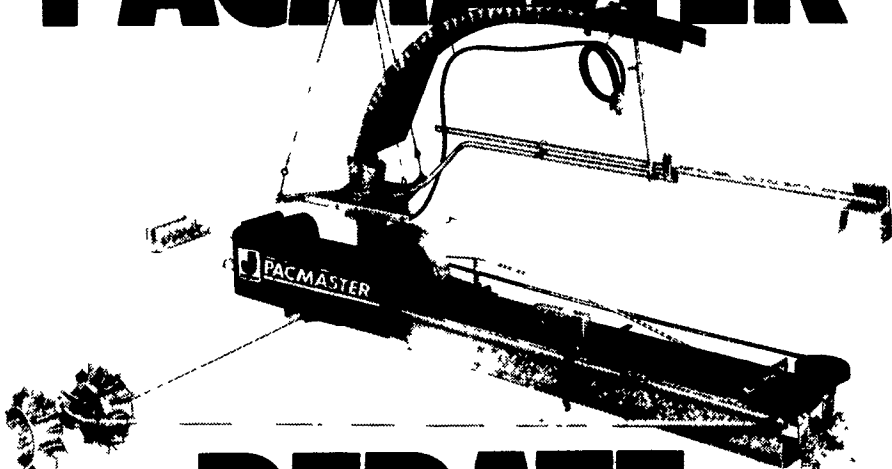
