Nominations Open

DES MOINES, Iowa. — The Pork Industry Nominating Committee has set a January 1, 1992 deadline to receive nominations to fill five, three-year terms on the National Pork Board. The positions are currently held by producers Tom Miller, Ariz.; Hilman Schroeder, Wis.; Gary Simpson, Colo.; Linden Olson, Minn.; and Harold Trask, Iowa.

A total of eight producers will be selected by the National Pork Producers (Pork Act) delegate body from nominees submitted to the nominating committee by state pork producer associations, other farm organizations, and individuals. Floor nominations may also be made at the annual meeting of the Pork Act Delegate Body,

March 6-7, 1992 in Atlanta, Ga.

The slate of eight producers will then be submitted to the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture, who will appoint five producers to fill the open pork board positions.

The Pork Industry Nominating Committee will consider the qualifications of all proposed candidates and will select candidates to participate in personal interviews in late January. The nominating committee will release its proposed slate of candidates in advance of the delegate body meeting in March.

Nomination applications to the National Pork Board are due by January 1, 1992 to the Pork Industry Nominating Committee, P.O. Box 10383, Des Moines, IA 50306.

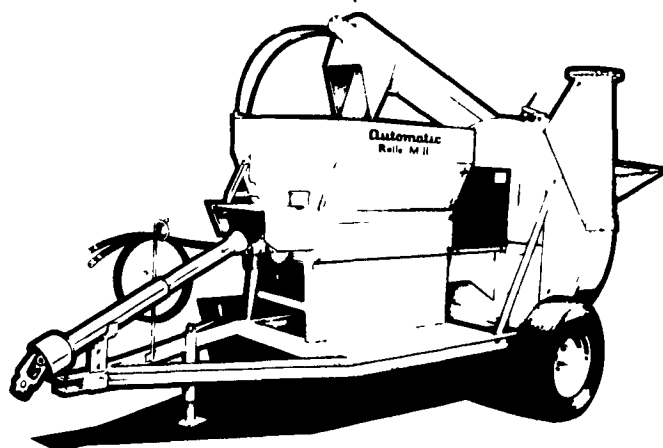
