

Enthusiasm Abounds At Polled Hereford National

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — The enthusiasm and excitement generated at the 69th National Polled Hereford Convention Show and Sale was contagious for all beef industry members who attended the 1991 North American International Livestock Exposition (NAILE).

Polled Hereford breeders united in full force to hold an energizing national convention and one of the largest shows at this year's NAILE. A \$9,176 average on select lots

consigned to the national sale climaxed the week that was a positive experience for all who attended this year's premier breed event recently in Louisville, Ky.

A strong showing of 312-head comprised the National Polled Hereford Show. It was officiated by a three-man team, including Canadian Polled Hereford breeder Bill Biglieni, Douglas, Man.; Limousin breeder Gene Raymond, Garnett, Kan.; and Clint Rusk, Colorado State University live-

stock judging team coach from Ft. Collins, Colo.

Topping the 108-head bull show was TRF ACE Equity 82Z, a May 1990 son of BB MSU 15S Wisdom. This intermediate and grand champion bull was bred by ACE Land & Cattle Co., Skiatook, Okla., and is owned by ACE; Maple Rock Farm, Pittsford, Vt.; Thud Ridge Farms, Wrightstown, N.J.; and KDW Cattle Co., Gardiner, Maine.

Winding up the premier female honors in the 192-head heifer and 12-head cow-calf show was the champion cow-calf, JR LB 621 Cassandra Y152 and her May '91 heifer calf. John E. Rice & Sons, Inc., Sheridan, Wyo., bred the pair which they co-own with Lloyd L. Brown, Powell, Wyo. Cassandra is a 2-year-old WS approval 621 daughter; her calf was sired by JR 257T Rancher Y131.

Reserve grand champion honors in the bull show were claimed by senior champion 4WF Eclipse 31Y. The coming three-year-old, sired by 5E SF 4WF 38 Special, was bred by Four Winds Farm, Berlin Conn., and is owned by Four Winds and Overlook Farm, Peterborough, N.H.

Junior member Joshua Brenizer, Cadott, Wis., owned the champion intermediate and reserve grand champion female, Sterling Ms America ET16. His May 1990

Winning the get-of-sire competition on their four progeny of Dunwalke Doctor K was Dunwalke Farm, Far Hills, N.J. Boyd Polled Herefords, Mays Lick, Ky., earned the calf get-of-sire banner for their group of Beau Donald Rival calves.

The best-six-head award was presented to Tammy Riffel, a junior member from Enterprise, Kan. Riffel was also the National's pre-

mier exhibitor. Premier breeder honors were awarded to ACE Land & Cattle Co., while the show's new exhibitor award went to Joshua Brenizer.

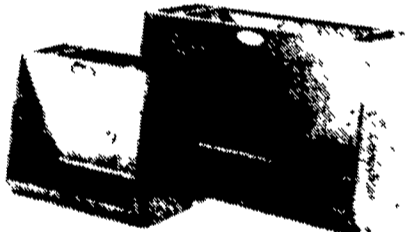

Photo shows relative size of double-sided Nursery feeder (ND-5) on left, and finisher feeds (FD-5) on right

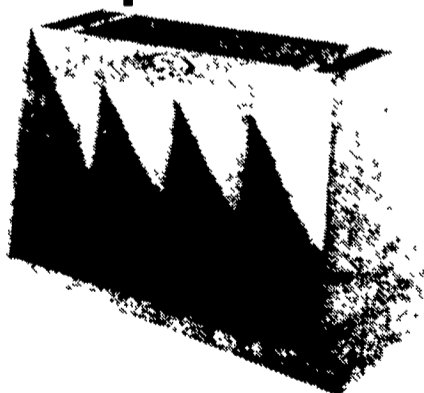

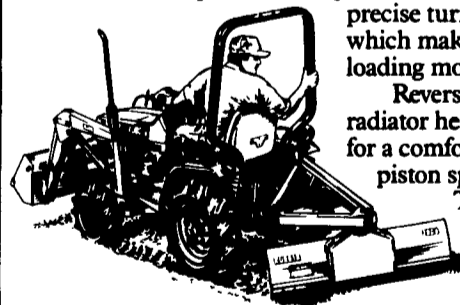
