STEEERS OVER 550 LB. & HEIFERS OF ALL WEIGHTS STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER; STEERS UNDER 550 LB. \$2.00-\$4.00 LOWER. DEMAND MODERATE EARLY, LIGHT LATE. BUYERS CONTINUE VERY SELECTIVE FOR KIND AND/OR CONDITION. FEEDER QUALITY AVERAGE. WEIGH-UPS AVERAGE. CATTLE CARRYING MOSTLY AVERAGE TO MODERATELY THIN CONDITION, HOWEVER SEVERAL FLESHY OR FED-AT CATTLE OFFERED. WEATHER REMAINED MILD THRU TUESDAY AFTER WHICH COOL STORM PATTERN BEGAN. GRAZABLE WHEAT THRUOUT THE WHEAT BELT IS SPOTTY. LARGE PORTION OF CROP HAS GOTTEN OFF TO A TERRIBLE START WHILE SMALLER ACREAGE HAS DONE WELL. TIME OF PLANTING WAS THE KEY TO GOOD OR BAD.
