USDA DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN MARKET SUMMARY WHEAT PRICES MIXED, MOSTLY LOWER; CORN AND BEAN PRICES HIGHER WED-NESDAY ON LACK OF EXPORT DEMAND, FUND BUYING AND RENEWED HOPES FOR USSR. WHEAT MIXED. CORN STEADY TO 6 CENTS HIGHER. SORGHUM 4 TO 5 CENTS HIGHER. SOYBEANS 1 TO 2 CENTS HIGHER. WHEAT PRICES MOSTLY LOWER WITH WEAKNESS COMING FROM ABSENCE OF USSR BIDS THIS WEEK AND COMMER-CIAL BEAR SPREADING FOR DECEMBER CONTRACTS. FURTHER DELAYS IN EXPECTED SOVIET BIDS FOR U.S. EXPORT BONUS WHEAT AND PROFIT TAKING ON THE BOARD CAUSED WEAKNESS BUT SCATTERED COMMERCIAL BUYING LIMITED PRICE DECLINES. FUND BUYING BROUGHT ON BY OPTIMIS-TIC OUTLOOK FOR CORN SALES TO USSR, ADDED STRENGTH TO PRICES. NEWS INDICATING SOVIET BANK OF FOREIGN ECONOMIC RELATIONS EXPECTED TO MAKE LARGE PRINCIPAL PAYMENTS ON EXPORT CREDIT LOAN, DUE EARLY IN 1992, PUSHED CORN PRICES SHARPLY HIGHER. SOYBEAN PRICES ALSO ADVANCED ON FUND BUYING AND RENEWED HOPES FOR SOVIET PURCHASES. THIS WEEK'S STORM IN ARGENTINA, WHICH SHOWERED LARGE HAIL OVER AT LEAST 247,000 ACRES OF HARD WHEAT AND SOYBEANS, ADDED SUPPORT TO BEAN PRICES. ARGEN-TINA HAS DECLARED "DISASTER

ZONE" STATUS BUT MUCH OF THE BEAN CROP CAN BE REPLANTED. EXPORT NEWS: TURKEY BOUGHT

3,000 TONNES SOYOIL AND 2,000 TONNES COTTONSEED OIL UNDER EXPORT BONUS PROGRAM AND COTTONSEED OIL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR DEC/JAN/FEB.

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
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
