



Ag Committee Meets At **Farm Show**

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.)- Farmers will have the chance to talk with top-level officials from both the PA Department of Agriculture and the Department of Environmental Resources at a meeting hosted by the Agricultural Advisory Committee, 9:30-11:30 a.m., Wednesday, January 15, room B of the Farm Show Complex.

"The officials at both departments develop many of the regulations and procedures which the farming community follows," said Steve Robinson, past chair of the committee. "This meeting will give farmers the opportunity to meet face-to-face with some of these officials and ask them questions."

Deputy Secretary Caren Glotfelty from DER and Deputy Secretary Walter Peetchatka from PDA will be on hand to answer questions. Other speakers and topics will include: Roger Fickes, chief of the Division of Rivers and Wetlands Conservation, on wetlands; Personnel from Bureau of Waste Management on compostresidual waste regulations; and Deputy Sec. Glotfelty on groundwater protection strategy. The Agricultural Advisory Committee advises both DER and the Department of Agriculture on regulations and policies affecting the farming community. Membership consists of representatives from the three general farm organizations, Penn State University, members of the House and Senate Ag and Rural Affairs committees and other agencies directly dealing with agriculture.




