

Teen Wins Scholarship

COLLEGE PARK, Md. - Melanie Crowder, 17, recently received a \$1,000 educational scholarship from ZIPLOC Freezer Bags, DowBrands, Inc., for her work in the national 4-H food conservation, preservation, and safety program.

Crowder, a student at Thomas Stone High School, and a resident of Waldorf, MD, was one of four 4-H'ers to be chosen by the Cooperative Extension System to receive the award, which was presented at the 70th National 4-H Congress in Chicago, December 7 to 11. Awards were arranged by the National 4-H Council.

Crowder received the award for progressive personal and skill development in the food conservation, preservation and safety program. After years of helping prepare foods for canning by her mother and grandmother, she was well prepared for her 4-H food preservation project.
