USDA DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN MARKET SUMMARY WHEAT AND SOYBEAN PRICES MADE STRONG COMEBACK AFTER MONDAY'S LOWER TREND. WHEAT 3 TO 7 CENTS HIGHER; CORN AND SORGHUM MINOR CHANGES; SOYBEANS 2 TO 3 CENTS HIGHER. GRAINS AND SOYBEANS IN STRONG HANDS, ESPECIALLY WHEAT. VERY GOOD RECENT EXPORT DEMAND AND REDUCED HOLDINGS, WHEAT STOCKS AT RECORD LOW, PAINTED BRIGHT PICTURE FOR NEXT YEARS TRADE. MONUMENTAL LOGISTICAL PROBLEMS OF CREDIT; PAYMENTS; WHERE, WHEN, AND HOW TRANSPORTED ALONG WITH LOCAL DISBURSMENT METHODS FACING THE NEW COMMON WELTH OF INDEPENDENT STATES. THE DEMAND IS THERE AND THE COMMODITIES ARE HERE. MUCH PRESS AND HEADLINES SO OWNERS TAKING STRONG STAND. WHEAT PRICES ALREADY AT 21 MONTH HIGH AND 1.50 ABOVE YEAR AGO WITH MANY COUNTRY ELEVATORS ABOVE 4.00 A BUSHEL. SOYBEANS WELL BELOW MAGICAL 6 00 A BUSHEL LEVEL AND 5 TO 10 CENTS BELOW A YEAR AGO. GRAINS INSPECTED FOR EXPORT THIS CROP YEAR SHOW WHEAT UP 16 PERCENT, CORN UP 2 PERCENT, AND SOYBEANS UP 29 PERCENT. WHEAT CROP YEAR BEGINS JUNE 1, CORN AND SOYBEANS SEPTEMBER 1 EXPORTS OFF TO A GOOD EARLY START AND THESE FIGURES DO NOT INCLUDE SOME RECENT BIG WHEAT SALES. ALSO HOPES HIGH FOR MORE ORDERS TO THE NEW REPUBLICS. THE USDA ANNOUNCED THAT EXPORT BONUSES CAN BE PAID ON COMMODITIES BOUGHT BY THE 12 INDIVIDUAL REPUBLICS.
