He said that successful marketing of milk depends on producers maintaining a consistent level of quality and production so that those trying to get the milk sold can make promises that the cooperative can live up to.

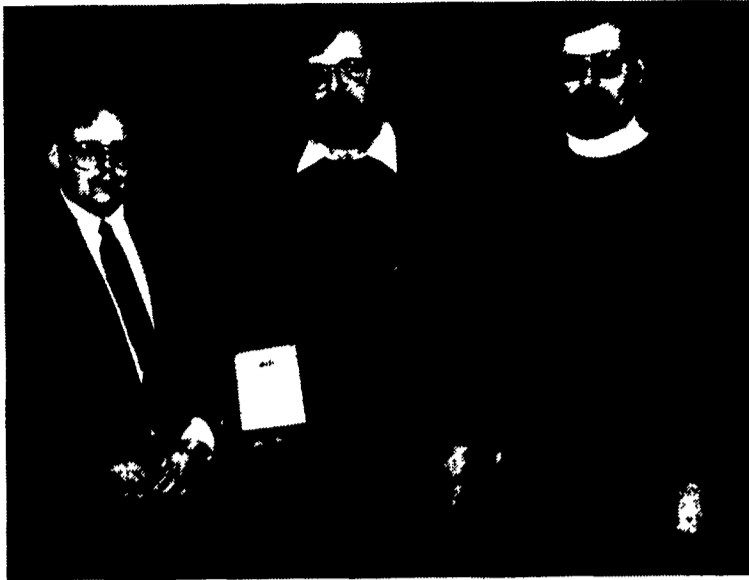
The production of high quality milk over the past year was good, he said. The cooperative paid out more than \$3 million in quality premiums.

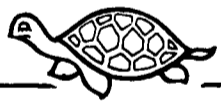
