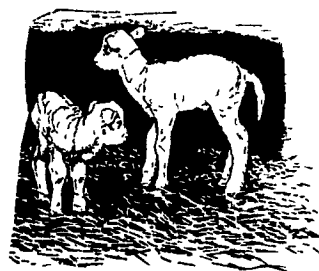
### Direct Marketing Symposium Set

Representatives of the American Sheep Industry Associations Lamb and Producers Services

Councils recently met with state department of agriculture and extension personnel to plan the first National Direct Marketing Conference for sheep producers. The conference is tentatively scheduled to take place in the Northeast in the fall of 1992.

The conference will feature speakers who have had success in direct marketing in ethnic markets, the freezer trade, gourmet and organic markets, mail order selling, wool and craft outlets, and lamb marketing co-ops.

Pennsylvania's representatives on the planning committee are Kathy Hamlett, department of agricultural economics and rural sociology and Clair Engle, department of dairy and animal science.



## Be On Lookout For New Fruit Variety

KEARNEYSVILLE, W.Va. — "Variety" is currently a dominant factor in apple marketing success. In place of Delicious, chain stores are now featuring varieties about which we know very little, such as Gala, Fuji, and Braeburn.

Do we jump on the bandwagon and plant one of the new hot varieties or do we search for new varieties which have the potential to give our region a market advantage? There are no simple answers, but it is evident that we need to expand variety testing in the Northeast.

The extension horticulturists of Pennsylvania, Virginia, Maryland, New Jersey, and West Virginia

have agreed to cooperate to establish a Mid-Atlantic Fruit Variety Testing Program, and we invite you to become a participant.

As a program participant, you will share your evaluations of new varieties with other growers in the region. In return, you will gain comprehensive information on which to base decisions on new plantings.

To become a variety testing participant, complete the attached application form, and we will begin sending you mailings on the testing which is occurring in our region.
