The right hybrids are still the best way to lower your cost of production.

Some of us were talking at coffee the other day about ways to cut our input costs for corn. One thing some of us are doing is to band our herbicide over the row instead of broadcasting it. We figure that probably saves us \$10 per acre.

Then I was looking at my own costs later and saw that Jacques 7820 was my biggest yielder last year by about six bushels over my next best hybrid. Even with corn at around \$2.25, that's over \$13 more per acre. And nobody at coffee thought about cutting costs by spreading them over more bushels!

Don't get me wrong. I'm still going to look for all the ways I can to cut production expenses. But the other side of that equation is bigger yields; and that's where my Jacques 7820 comes in.
