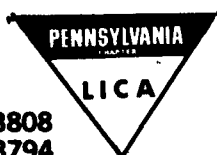

Workshop Assists Pasture Managers

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — On Monday, February 10, a Pasture Management Workshop will be presented by Penn State University and Soil Conservation Service (SCS) from 10 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. at the Days Inn Airport.

The purpose of the workshop is to provide management assistance to anyone who utilizes pastures for their livestock — dairy, beef, sheep, goats, or horses.

Featured speakers and topics include Dr. Marvin Hall, Penn State agronomist, who will discuss pasturing basics and renovation

techniques; Don Lindsay, SCS, will address water system alternatives and nutrient management; and Luther Smith, Penn State farm management agent, will present information on economics of pasture management.

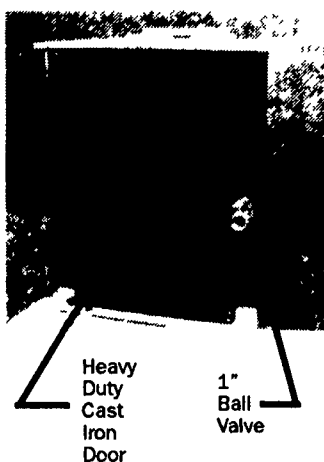
