

Observe Farm Tools, Machinery At Museum

WESTMINSTER, Md. — The Carroll County Farm Museum is accepting group tour reservations for the 1992 season.

Tour groups consisting of 20 or more people are welcome on weekdays in April 1992, Tuesday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Reservations are necessary.

Groups will have the opportunity to explore a bit of the past. This

educational tour depicts 1800s farm family life and includes a guided tour through the Farmhouse.

There are self-guided tours through exhibit rooms where artisans may demonstrate period skills, out-building exhibitions of old-fashioned transportation, farming tools and farm machinery on display, a "hands-on" room,

and farm animals to see. The General Store is open for business.

The museum will open weekends starting May 2 through October 25, 1992, noon until 5 p.m.

The museum will open weekdays July and August, 1992, Tuesday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Weekend hours continue until October 25, 1992, noon until

5 p.m.

The Farm Museum also provides a lovely backdrop for company picnics, family reunions, wedding receptions, or birthday parties. Pavilions may be reserved for a small fee for just such occasions.

Theme days will be an additional attraction. Visitors can explore various aspects of 19th century

ways of life.

Scheduled theme days include a Victorian tea party in the flower garden and an Olde Tyme Puppet Theatre. Craft classes will be offered in the spring and fall.

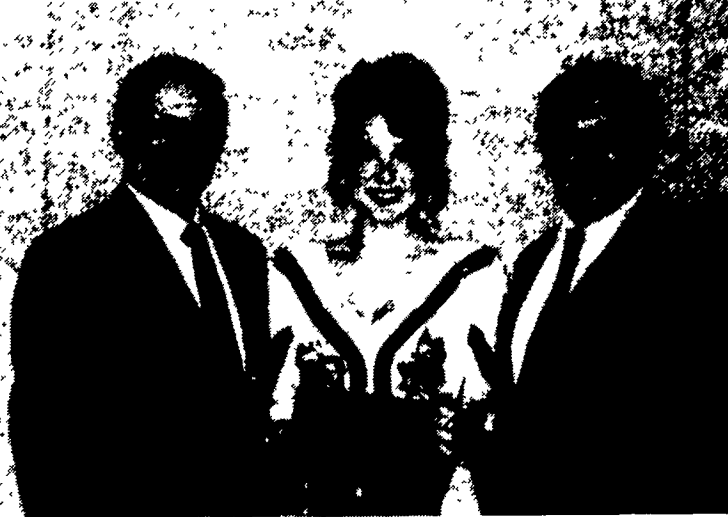
Auctioneers Attend Convention

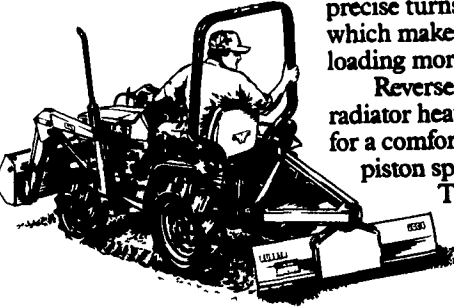

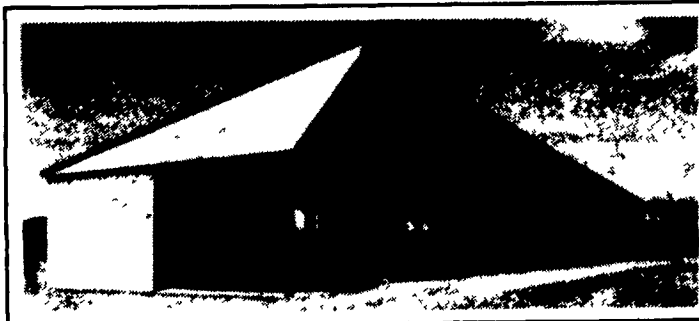

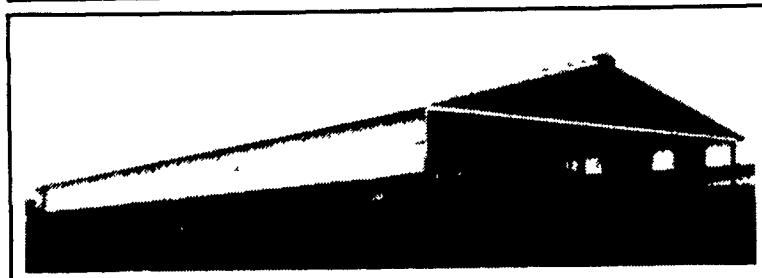
