### 24-Month Calving Is Okay

STATE COLLEGE (Centre Co.) — Age at calving and production in first lactation for Holstein heifers has been summarized from the past four years of DHIA tested herd information.

Avg Age at Calving 27.0 26.8 26.7 26.5

The average age at first calving for Holstein heifers has dropped by half a month in four years. If there is a potential saving of from one to two dollars per day, this reduction in age at calving has saved Pennsylvania dairymen from 1.2 to 2.4 million dollars in 1990-91 compared to 1987-88. However, there is still plenty of room for improvement as the table below indicates:


