#### Swiss-Style Mocha

½ cup instant coffee

1/2 cup sugar

2 tablespoons cocoa

cup nonfat dry milk

Combine and store in airtight container. For one serving, use 1 tablespoon plus  $\bar{1}$  teaspoon of mix to 1 cup boiling water. Makes 24 servings.

ANSWER — Ralph Baer, Temple, requested a recipe for cup cheese that includes full instructions. Thanks to Joan Stump of Stump Hollow Dairy Goats, Telford, for sending recipes.

#### Cup Cheese

2½ gallons thick sour milk

11/2 teaspoons baking soda

1½ teaspoons salt

1/2 cup water

Heat milk to 120 degrees or until it is too hot to hold your finger in it. Drain and allow to stand in cheesecloth bag until the next day. Crumble curds or put them through food processor until fine. Mix soda through cheese and place into a crock or large mixing bowl. Cover with a cloth and allow to stand 3 days at room temperature. Stir each morning and evening. At the end of the third day, the cheese should appear yellow and gummy, and have a sharp odor.

Set crock or bowl containing cheese in a boiler of hot water. Add salt and water, then stir until smooth. Pour into custard cups. When cold, spread on bread.

### Crock Cheese

1 gallon thick sour milk

1½ tablespoons butter

11/2 teaspoons salt


3 cup cream

1/4 teaspoon baking soda

Scald milk to 120 degrees or until too hot to put finger in it. Drain through a fine colander or cloth bag. Let stand overnight to drain thoroughly.

Place into a crock or deep bowl and crumble until fine. Add salt and mix well.

Cover with a cloth and set to ripen at room temperature for 3 days. Mix baking soda into the cheese and let stand for 3 hours.

### **America Honors Food Providers**

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The more than 20 million men and women who provide the food and fiber Americans use every day will be honored during National Agriculture Week March 15 through 21. National Agriculture Day is March 20.

"Without a national observance, it is too easy to forget the importance of the American food and agriculture industry in our daily lives," says Bud Porter, chairman of the nationwide celebration. "We forget that our food and agriculture industry puts food on our table, clothes on our back, and shelter over our heads each day.

National Agriculture Day, National Agriculture Week and National Women in Agriculture Day on March 19, coincide with the beginning of spring when thousands of farmers across the country are preparing their fields for planting. The annual observance is designed to direct attention to the important contributions made by the food and agriculture industry.

"For many Americans raised in the city, agriculture is as mysterious as a college level course in trigonometry," says Porter. "As a result, we have to help the public understand the challenges the industry faces in continuing to meet our food and fiber needs. We also must make them aware of the important stake they have in the future of our food and agriculture industry."

For example, Porter says the tood and agriculture industry represents nearly 16 percent of the Gross National Product and an'

estimated 21 million jobs (or 17 percent of the total national work force). Yet approximately 90 percent of the industry's jobs are off the farm. According to Porter, this means that Americans don't have to live on a farm to have their livelihood depend on agriculture.

In fact, he says a large segment of the population depends on agriculture but have never been on a

"Not many people are really aware of the connection — they see themselves as totally removed from agriculture, not realizing that their economic well-being as well as their daily sustenance is interwoven with our food and agriculture industry."

Porter is director of sales branches at Deere & Company, a farm implement manufacturer based in Moline, Ill. He is a board member of the Agriculture Council of America (ACA), the national coordinator of National Agriculture Day.

To mark National Agriculture Day and National Agriculture Week 1992, the fifth of a five-year series of original oil paintings has been created. "Sharing Our Finest" is the title of this year's painting, which depicts a farmers' market. Posters of the painting have been produced and distributed by a number of agricultural groups and state departments of agriculture across the country. In addition, countless number of activities will be held in conjunction with National Agriculture Week and National Agriculture Day, includ-


ing shopping mall displays, agricultural teach-ins or educational programs and special breakfasts and luncheons recognizing the industry.

In Lincoln, Neb., for example, a special breakfast featuring state agricultural products will be held. Guests will be served food ranging from beef jerky to soy-fried donuts. And the York Area Chamber of Commerce will mark the occasion by sponsoring an Ag Day Exchange in which farmers and ranchers exchange jobs for a day with other area business people and vice versa. What's more, all state departments of agriculture will generate official proclamations of Agriculture Day from the nation's governors.

In Washington, D.C., a national proclamation will be signed by the President to show support for the food and agriculture industry. In addition, a reception will be held on Capitol Hill to remind legislators of the important role the industry plays in their state and national economies.

ACA is a broad-based membership organization of farmers and ranchers, local, state, and national commodity organizations, agribusinesses and other interests that work together to promote and build support for the food and agriculture industry.
