Oklahoma City Feeder Cattle March 4, 1992

Compared with last week: Feeder cattle and calves closed mostly steady to \$1.00 higher. Market opened weak early Monday but gained *momentum thruout the trading period to close higher. Trade active. Demand very good with several outside buying interests competing aggressively for large run. This weeks run is the largest in three years at the Oklahoma National. Flesh condition rather thick on feeders and more reminiscent of May feeders off wheat as March feeders are generally not near as fleshy. Weigh condition less attractive to buyers with cattle on fuller end of scale. Cattle are exiting wheat pastures a few weeks early due to fast wheat growth causing wheat toxicity in cattle. Slaughter cows Cutter and Boning Utility (thin) steady; fleshy cows and Canners \$2.00 lower. Demand good for thin cows; only fair for larger supply of fat cows. Slaughter bulls under good demand and \$1.00-\$2.00 up. Receipts this week 20,922; last week 17,218; last year 16,210. Supply includes 80 percent yearlings; 18 percent calves and stockers under 600 lbs.; 2 percent cows and bulls. Bulk price ranges




