Tip of the Week

Out of shaving cream? Substitute creme rinse or shampoo applied to wet skin.

EARTHWISE

Caustic drain cleaners may work wonders on your clogged drain, but they wreak havoc on the environment. If an old-fashioned plunger won't clear your drain, try this non-toxic recipe: Pour 1/2 cup baking soda, 1/2 cup salt, and 1/4 cup vinegar down the drain, in that order. Close the drain until the fizzing stops, then flush with boiling water. Remember to use a drain sieve to trap hair and objects and prevent clogging.

WEATHER FORECAST

NORTHEAST: Mild, rainy east, cold and snowy west, then clear and milder followed by snow.

SOUTHEAST: Clear and warm north coast and deep south, showery and seasonable, warm Florida.

MIDWEST: Mostly clear and warm, light snow north, turning colder, snow-storm, rain east.

NORTHWEST: Cloudy showers, sunny north then cold and snowy, drizzle coast, sunny and milder, snow and rain mountains.

SOUTHWEST: Warm, sunny east, heavy rain elsewhere, snow mountains, clear, warm desert.

ORANGE SCONES

Combine first five ingredients. Cut in butter with pastry blender until mixture forms coarse crumbs. Add raisins and toss. Add egg and buttermilk, stir just until mixture holds together. (Dough will be sticky, if dry, add another tablespoon of buttermilk.) Knead 8-10 times on a floured board. Gently pat into 9" circle. Cut into 12 wedges and place on a cookie sheet. Bake at 400° F for about 12 minutes, until golden. Serve warm with butter and marmalade. **Makes 12 scones.**
