Aphanomyces root rot of alfalfa is a soil borne fungus which causes death and stunting of seedlings and chronic disease of established plants.



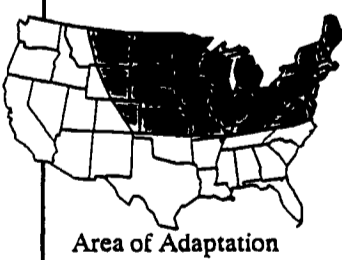
