Poultry Workshop On April 25

FOREST HILL, Md.—Harford County Extension Service will be sponsoring a Small Poultry Flock Husbandry Workshop on Saturday, April 25 at 8:30 a.m. at the Harford County Extension Office.

This workshop will feature topics that relate to backyard poultry producers and the commercial poultry marketer.

Dr. Charles Wabeck, extension specialist for poultry food products, will start off the discussion with comments on purchasing and


selecting chicks and what to do when the birds arrive. Discussing housing and equipment will be Mike Bazley, Baltimore County agricultural agent.

A major concern for many flock owners centers on disease management. Dr. Ed Mallinson, extension veterinarian, poultry, at the College of Veterinary Medicine at College Park, will discuss flock health and disease management. Of equal concern is the proper ration mix for the backyard and

commercial flock, which will be addressed by Robert Halman, Harford County agricultural agent.

To round out the day's program, scheduled is Dianna Baldwin, agriculture inspector with egg marketing, food safety, and regulations.
