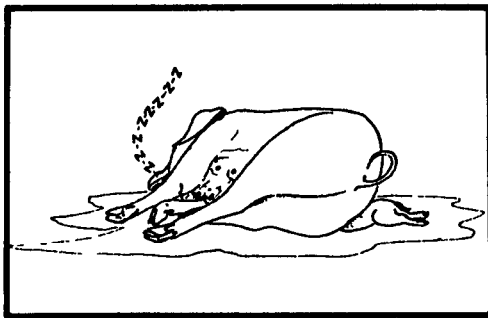

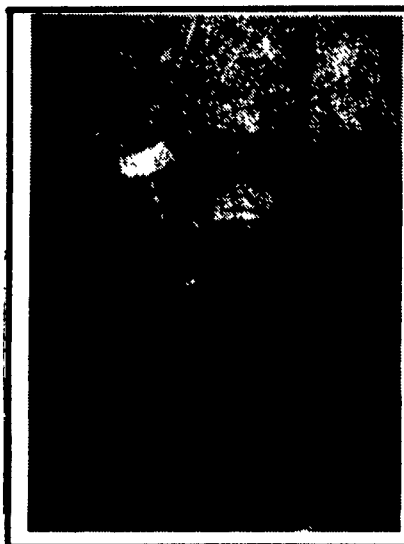


Hydraulic Farrowing Crate PREVENTS CRUSHING

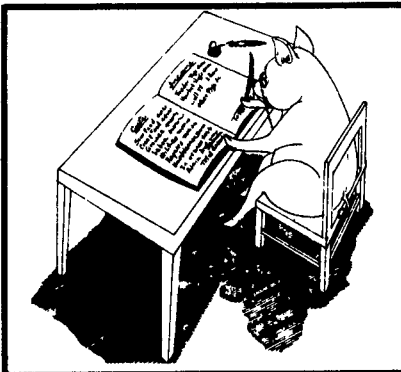
