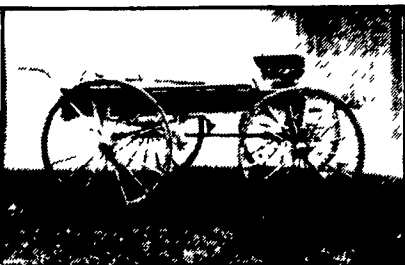

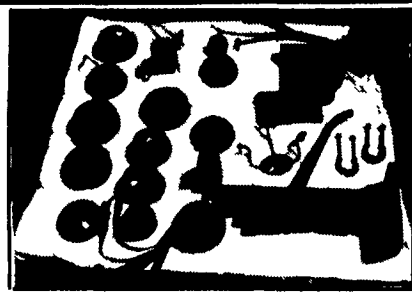

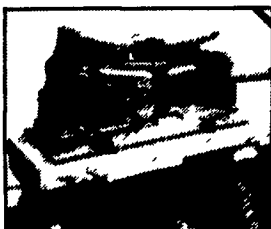


One Of A Variety Of Nice 4 & 6 Passenger Surreys.
