Compared with last week: Steers over 700 lbs. steady with good demand; under 700 lb. steers \$1.00- \$3.00 lower with moderate demand. Heifers closed steady to \$1.00 lower; however heifers over 700 lbs. sold steady to \$1.00 higher on majority of sales Monday. Heifer demand good early, poor late on light numbers and rough CME. Stocker buyers are in their seasonal doldrums as wheat is done and grass just starting. Pastures in this region are getting a fairly good start for summer. This week is thought to be the last big run of the wheat season. Quality of cattle well below most sales this wheat season. This suggests the end of the wheat run as the tail-enders come to town. Weigh conditions were mostly average, end full. Bulk supply was 700-900 lb. steers and 650-800 lb. heifers. Slaughter cows \$1.75-\$2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls \$1.00 higher. Receipts this week 15,200; last week 14,949; last year 12,758. Supply consisted of 89% yearlings over 600 lbs.; 7% calves; 4% cows and bulls. 
