USDA DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN SUMMARY GRAIN AND SOYBEAN PRICES RECEIVED ANOTHER SUBSTANTIAL PUSH UPWARD, WEDNESDAY, AS OUTLOOK FOR POSSIBLE RAINS DIMINISH. WHEAT 2 TO 7 CENTS HIGHER. CORN 2 TO 6 CENTS HIGHER. SORGHUM 4 TO 5 CENTS HIGHER. SOYBEANS 1 TO 5 CENTS HIGHER. SURGING GRAIN PRICES, REACTION TO LATEST WEATHER FORECAST FOR DIMINISHED CHANCE OF RAINS THIS WEEK IN KEY GROWING AREAS OF U.S. WET WEATHER CONTINUES TO DELAY HARVEST ACTIVITY IN TEXAS. ACTIVE EXPORT INTERESTS, ESPECIALLY FOR CORN, ALSO ADDED TO PRICE GAINS. INDICATIONS RECENT COLD SNAP THIS WEEK MIGHT HAVE NIPPED SOME CORN CROPS IN NORTHERN GROWING STATES, BOOSTED CORN PRICES. INCREASE IN EXPORT INSPECTION FIGURES FOR WHEAT AND BEANS, AN ADDED FACTOR IN HIGHER PRICES.

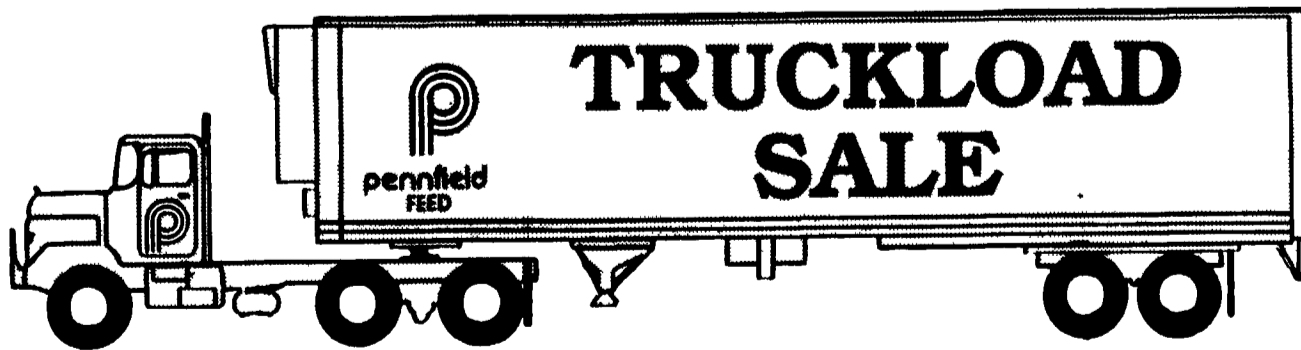
