his fellow directors to insure the highest possible quality of education, but with consideration of expenses so that taxpayers will not be unduly burdened.

Zick expressed concern over the difficult times being experienced by dairy farmers. While he believes that his operation can survive, because of efficiency and home-grown labor, he worries that

many others are nearly at a breaking point.

Last year's drought made conditions worse, and any further disasters could well mark the demise of many near-marginal operations. He is also concerned about the high costs of capitalizing a dairy farm, and wonders how younger men and women can get started in the business.

Science Teacher To Attend Ag Workshop

CHAMBERSBURG (Adams Co.) — Donald Summers, a 4th grade science teacher at the Bermudian Springs Elementary School, has been selected to attend the new program, initiated by the Pennsylvania Foundation For Better Living and the Adams County Farmers' Association, in which he will learn to "feed minds for a successful tomorrow."

According to committee selection chairman Ed Wilkinson, "Mr. Summers is committed to increasing the understanding and awareness of the interdependence of people, food, fiber and the environment among Pennsylvania's elementary and secondary school students, educators, farmers, and

the general public for the purpose of encouraging critical thinking and wise decision making to maintain a viable agricultural system conducive to a healthy and economically stable society."

The fun-filled, hands-on workshop will be conducted July 20-23 at the Pennsylvania State University to focus on the wholistic educational approach, enabling elementary teachers to develop projects and lessons that integrate agricultural concepts into their existing curriculum.

Participants are requested upon completing the workshop to return

to the county and share materials and ideas with other local teachers.

As a teacher sponsor, the Adams County Farmers' Association will be establishing an agriculturally literate "ambassador" in the county, committed to increasing the understanding of the relationship between agriculture, consumers, and the economy.

The workshops will be geared toward teachers with no or limited agricultural background. The participants will be introduced to numerous resources.

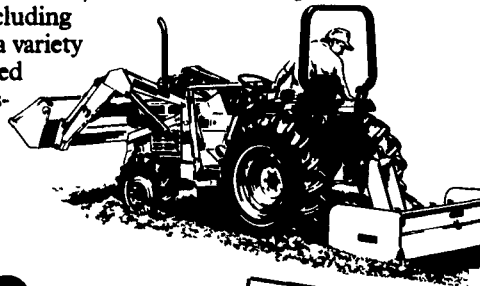
