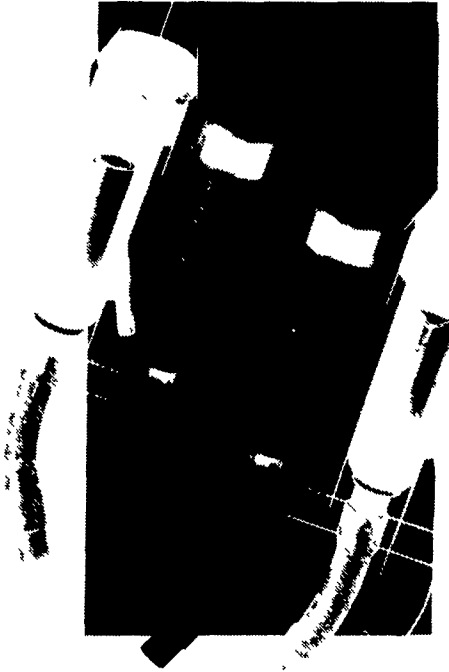


Three-Way Messaging Action
