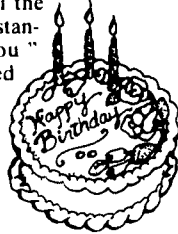

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY, MILDRED!**

June 27th is the birthday of Mildred J. Hill, a schoolteacher born in Kentucky in 1859. Almost no one knows of Ms. Hill, but everybody knows the melody she composed, first published in 1893 in *Song Stories for the Sunday School*. The lyrics were written by Patty Smith Hill, the composer's younger sister, and the song, entitled "Good Morning to All," was intended to be sung in school classrooms. The song's popularity did not blossom until the lyrics were amended in 1924 to include a stanza beginning "Happy Birthday to You." "Happy Birthday to You" is now believed to be the world's most often-sung song celebrating a birthday every minute of the day.

A good song is none the worse for being sung twice.

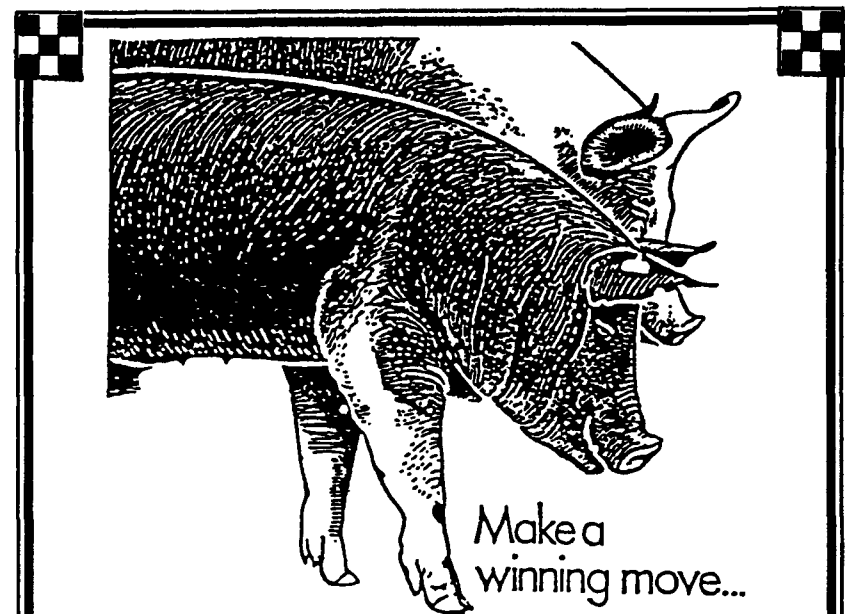
**EARTHWISE**

Trees need carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) and produce oxygen. People need oxygen and produce CO<sub>2</sub> — we were meant to coexist in balance. But between the 1950s and 1980, the Earth's forested area was reduced by 25%. Trees shading your home can lower the temperature by 10° and reduce energy demand by 10-50%. **PEASCODS**

- 1 1/2 pounds baby green sugar peas in pods
- 1/2 cup water
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon mace
- 1 egg yolk
- 2 tablespoons dry sherry
- 2 tablespoons vinegar

Clean and rinse pods. Bring water, butter, salt, and mace to boil. Add peas, cover, and reduce heat to medium. Cook 6-8 minutes, or until peas are tender-crisp, stirring once or twice. Beat egg yolk with sherry and vinegar. Reduce heat to low and slowly pour egg mixture into peas in a thin stream, stirring constantly. Serve at once. **Makes 6 servings.**

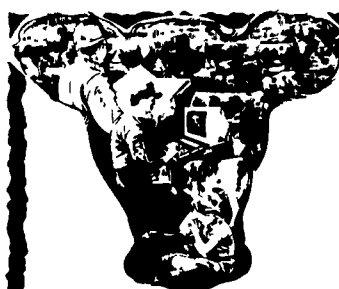
