

U. Of Md. Appoints Director

COLLEGE PARK, Md. — Dr. Bryan H. Johnson will become acting Maryland Agricultural Experiment Station director when current director Robert A. Kennedy departs for Texas A&M University in August 1992.

"Having served as associate director since November 1989, Bryan is intimately acquainted with MAES programs and Maryland's agricultural and natural resource base," said Dr. Raymond J. Miller, president of the Maryland Institute for Agriculture and Natural Resources. "Thus I am

fully confident that MAES, under Bryan's leadership, will continue its agricultural and environmental research initiatives throughout the University of Maryland System."

Johnson, 51, received his Ph.D. Degree in animal breeding and reproductive physiology from Oklahoma State University. Prior to coming to MAES, he was head of the animal science department at the University of Wyoming in Laramie.

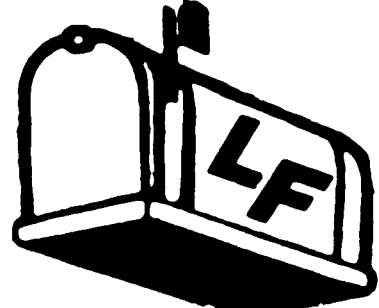
