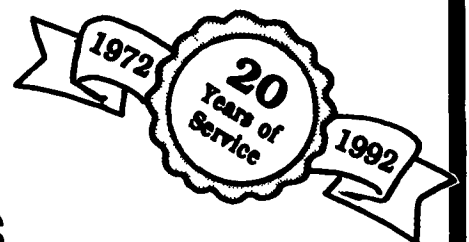

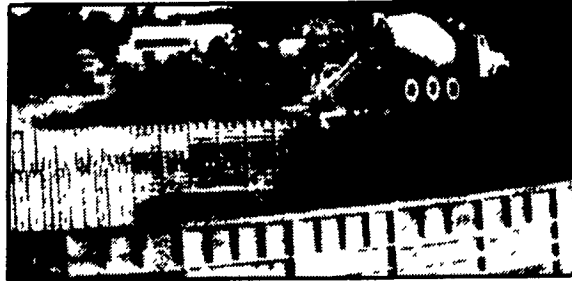

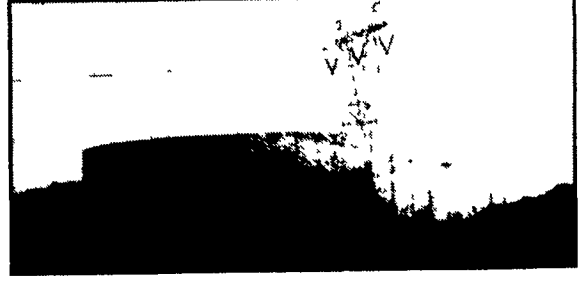

 Far Right: 2 Silage Pits In-Barn Manure Receiving Pit



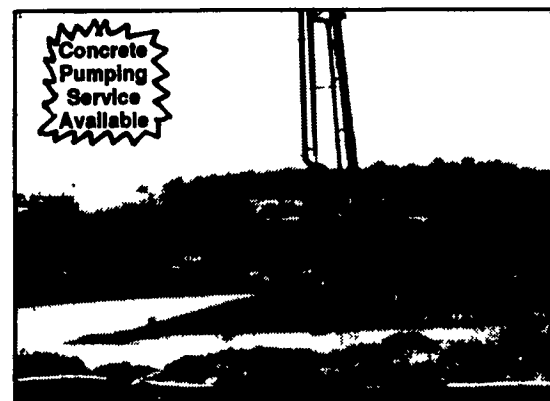
Construction Of Partially In-Ground Liquid Manure Tank - 400,000 Gallons
