DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN SUMMARY WHEAT PRICES MOSTLY HIGHER ON HARVEST DELAYS; CORN AND BEAN PRICES SLIGHTLY LOWER ON RAINY MIDWEST WEATHER. WHEAT MIXED, FROM 2 TO 6 CENTS HIGHER TO 6 CENTS LOWER IN MINNEAPOLIS. CORN STEADY TO 2 CENT LOWER. SORGHUM STEADY TO 2 CENTS LOWER. SOYBEANS 2 TO 4 CENTS LOWER. CONTINUED RAINY WEATHER IN MIDWEST AREAS LIMITED WHEAT HARVEST ACTIVITY, ESPECIALLY IN SOFT RED WINTER WHEAT AREAS. CONCERNS OVER QUALITY OF YIELDS, ADDED TO STRENGTH IN WHEAT PRICES. GOOD EXPORT DEMAND FOR WHEAT THIS WEEK. MINNEAPOLIS TRUCK WHEAT POSTED LOWER PRICES AS HARVEST JUST AROUND THE CORNER AND NEARBY NEEDS LIGHT. RAIN AND MILD TEMPERATURES IN MIDWEST REGIONS RELIEVED DRY WEATHER STRESS IN CORN AND BEAN CROPS, PUSHING PRICES LOWER. WEATHER OUTLOOK CALLING FOR ABOVE-NORMAL RAIN AND MILD TEMPERATURES. SOYBEAN PRICES ALSO PRESSURED BY TURNAROUND IN SOYMEAL TRADE.  
EXPORT NEWS: JORDAN BOUGHT 118,350 METRIC TONS HARD RED WINTER WHEAT FOR 92/93. CCC BOUGHT FOR SOMALIA, 30,000 TONNES U.S. SOFT RED WINTER WHEAT FOR JULY/AUGUST SHIPMENT. THE JAPANESE FOOD AGENCY BOUGHT 119,000 TONNES U.S. WHEAT FOR SEPTEMBER REQUIREMENTS. BANGLADESH BOUGHT 25,000 TONNES U.S. HARD RED WINTER WHEAT UNDER EEP FOR AUGUST DELIVERY. SOUTH AFRICA BOUGHT 199,000 TONNES U.S. CORN FOR OCT/NOV SHIPMENT. KOREA BOUGHT 60,000 TONNES U.S. SOYMEAL FOR NOVEMBER SHIPMENT.





