Compared with last week: Feeder cattle and calves steady to \$2.00 lower; feeder market improved towards steady side since noon Monday. Initial demand light for all classes but improved considerably to moderate to good as cattle futures more optimistic than expected following last Friday's C.O.F. report. Weigh conditions uneven gaunt to full. Flesh condition of feeders attractive, average to slightly thin. Quality of supply not as good as past few weeks, plain to average with modest end attractive.

Pasture conditions remain excellent throughout this trade territory with good thundershower activity. Slaughter cows steady to \$1.00 lower, Utilities at full decline. Slaughter bulls steady. Demand moderate for slaughter cattle. Receipts this week 7,660; last week 12,224; last year 7,846. Supply consisted of 73% yearlings over 600 lbs.; 21% calves; 6% cows and bulls. 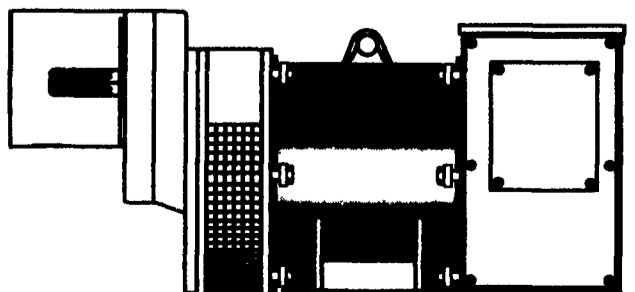

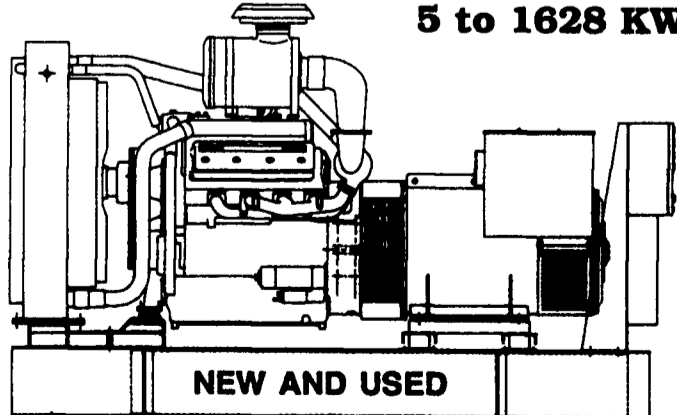
