\*\*Attention Dodge City\*\* OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY: Compared with last week: Feeder steers and steer calves firm to \$2.00 higher, fully eliminating losses of early last week. Feeder heifers and heifer calves steady. Demand very good for all grades; greatest improvement in demand was for plain yearling cattle as buyers seek numbers thus forecasting quality. Trade active on steers, moderate for heifers. Weigh conditions gaunt to full. Flesh conditions of yearlings attractive, mostly slightly thin. Quality of supply plain to attractive, with plain to average yearlings comprising bulk. Trade area continues to receive abundant moisture.

COMPARED TO LAST YEAR: Feeder steers over 600 lbs. \$2.00-\$2.75 lower. Feeder heifers over 500 lbs. \$1.50-\$2.50 lower. Prices now more in line with year ago due to raises in feeder cattle market since June 1992 and equivalent losses in feeder market in late July of 1991. Slaughter cows steady to \$2.00 higher, advance

on Cutters. Slaughter bulls steady. Demand good for cows, especially Cutters; moderate for bulls. Receipts this week 7,875; last week 7,666; last year 6,074. Supply consisted of 84% yearlings over 600 lbs.; 11% calves; 5% cows and bulls. Bulk prices follow; weighted average prices in parenthesis:

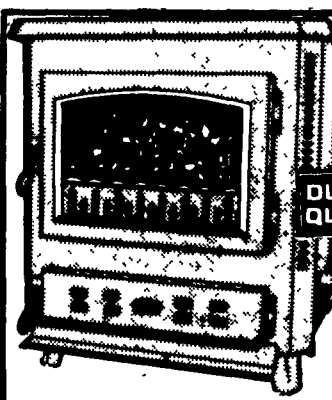
