The Limousin champion, and all breed reserve champion, was a summer yearling, Red Dawn, shown by Mark Mesler, Port Allegany RD.

First place light-weight steer, was an Angus, shown by Patrick Hoopes. Chad Carpenter, Shinglehouse, took first place in medium weight steer and grand champion steer.

Top heavy weight steer, Lofton, an Angus/Hereford, was shown by Nate Howard, Port Allegany, RD.

The reserve champion steer was Big Red, a Simmental, shown by Donald R. Snyder, Westfield.

Stacey Hamilton, Ulysses, took first place in feeder cattle, medium weight with her entry.

Chad Carpenter, Shinglehouse, took first place in senior showmanship and fitting; Donald Snyder, Westfield, took second place in showmanship and fitting, while Christy Hoopes, Ulysses, was third in showmanship, and Aaron Bartas, Port Allegany RD, third, in fitting.

Stacey Hamilton took first place in both showmanship and fitting in the intermediate age group, with Preston Hoopes, Ulysses, second in both categories and Mark Mesler, Port Allegany RD, third in

both showmanship and fitting, and Nate Howard, Port Allegany RD, was second in both categories.

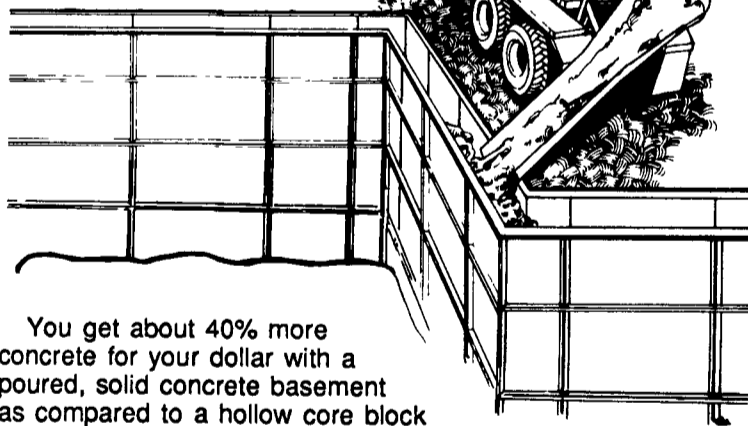
