Bold Ruler 101 won the grand champion title for Ty Krebs, Gordon, Nebraska. Weighing in at 1,173 pounds the steer had a weight per day of age of 2.68 pounds. He is a May 1991 son of Ankonian Bold Ruler A5208.

The reserve grand champion steer was Daltons Starman 174 owned by Bradley Lutz, Mount Jackson, Virginia. The March 1991 son of F F Starstruck weighed in at 1,245 pounds and had a weight per day of age of 2.59 pounds.

Alora Foster, Wichita Falls, Texas, exhibited this grand champion cow-calf pair at the 1992 National Junior Angus Show. The winning cow is R&J Lady 1360, a May 1990 daughter of Jacs Hudson. An April heifer calf sired by Fairfield Dark Star P57 was at her side.

Ty Krebs displayed the reserve grand champion cow-calf pair. F F Starlite Belle 690 is the name of the reserve grand winner that had an April heifer calf sired by Kesslers Rainman 002 at her side. The cow is a May 1990 daughter of F F Starstruck.

Bryan Bouldin, Rogersville, Missouri, exhibited the grand champion bred-and-owned bull that first won the junior championship. The grand winner is R V Rookie, a January 1991 son of Mickey. In winning the grand banner, the bull topped 42 other entries.

The reserve grand champion bred-and-owned bull was Mc Clarnon Prompter owned by Jamie Brown, Greenfield, Indiana.

The February 1991 bull is a son of Leachman Prompter. He first won reserve junior champion laurels.

More than 500 National Junior Angus Association (NJAA) members from 32 states and Canada participated in this record-breaking event.

## New England Horses Quarantined

**HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.)** — Prompted by reports of outbreaks of equine viral arteritis (EVA) at race tracks in New Hampshire and Massachusetts, Pennsylvania Agriculture Secretary Boyd E. Wolff imposed a ban on the import of horses into the commonwealth from the six New England states.

The import ban prohibits the movement or transportation of horses into Pennsylvania from

Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont, Rhode Island, Maine, and Connecticut.

The symptoms of EVA, a highly contagious disease, include fever and eye and nasal discharges. The disease, which is rarely fatal, may cause lameness in some horses.

A vaccine to prevent the disease is available from veterinarians.

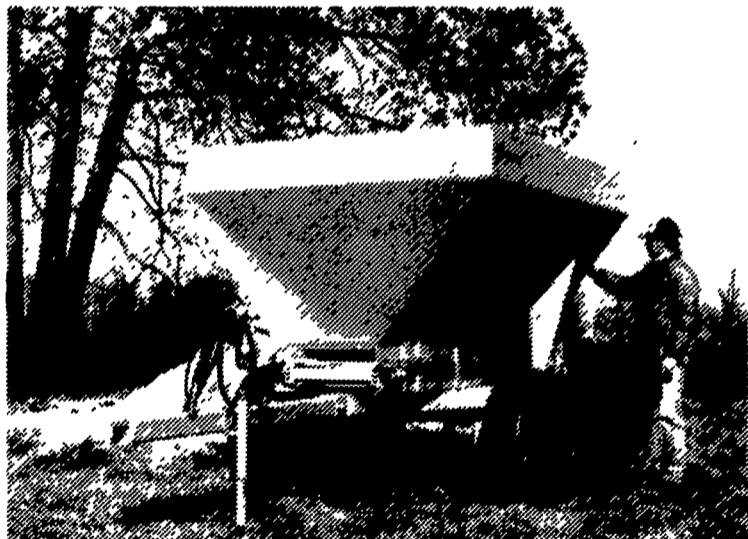

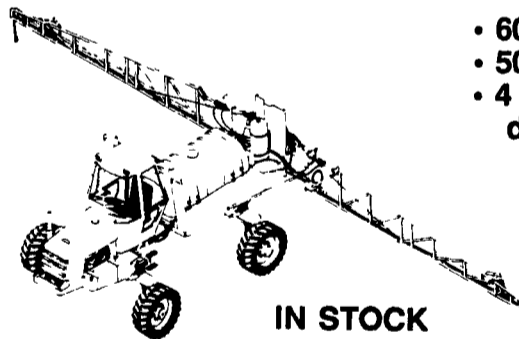

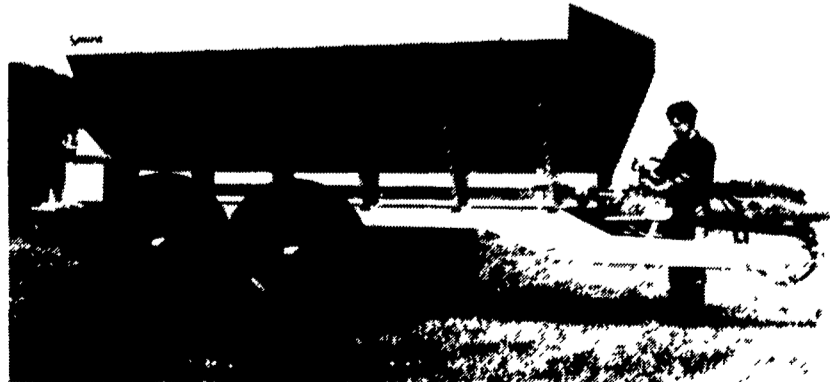
