When properly used, these programs should help to prevent nutritionally related problems with production, milk composition and health. Excesses or deficiences can be flagged to the memeber and his nutritional consultant on a regular basis or whenever requested, not necessarily on DHI test day.

Similarly, concentrate feeding levels and nutrient specifications can be obtained at any time. How-

ever, both evaluation and recommendations must be requested for proper processing.

The goal of the program is to provide additional and more detailed feeding information than previously available through DHI and to assist dairymen in improving the profitability of their herd.
