
Charolais Tops Elizabethtown Beef Show

mal, along with a complete show record of your animal's placings.

A panel of judges will evaluate each class and name an All-Pennsylvania winner for each class, and reserve and honorable mention winners.

STATE COLLEGE (Centre Co.) — The Junior All-Pennsylvania Awards will be made in 1992 under the following rules:

CLASSES RECOGNIZED

Spring Heifer Calf — born March 1, 1992 to April 30, 1992. Winter Heifer Calf — born Dec. 1, 1991 to Feb. 29, 1992. Fall Heifer Calf — born Sept. 1, 1991 to Nov. 30, 1991.

Summer Yearling Heifer — born June 1, 1991 to August 31, 1991. Spring Yearling Heifer — born March 1, 1991 to May 31, 1991. Winter Yearling Heifer — born Dec. 1, 1990 to Feb. 28, 1991.

Fall Yearling Helfer — born Sept. 1, 1990 to Nov. 30, 1990.

Junior 2-Year-Old — born March 1, 1990 to August 31, 1990.

Senior 2-Year-Old — born Sept. 1, 1989 to Feb. 28, 1989.

Junior 3-Year-Old — born March 1, 1989 to August 31, 1989.

Senior 3-Year-Old — born Sept. 1, 1988 to Feb. 28, 1989.

Four-Year-Old — born Sept. 1, 1987 to August 31, 1988. Five-Year-Old — born Sept. 1, 1986 to August 31, 1987.

160,000 Pound Class — cows any age which have benn shown in the 100,000 pound class. (NOTE: An animal can be entered in either the 100,000 pound class, or an individual class, not both.)

Aged Cow - born prior to Sept. 1, 1986.

OWNERSHIP

Each animal competing must be registered in the Herd Book of the Holstein-Freisian Association of America in the name of its Junior exhibitor and meet the requirements of Junior project work and for exhibition at 4-H, FFA, or Junior state shows or fairs. The exhibitor must be the sole owner of the animal at all shows in which she is exhibited.

The title must be by Jan. 1, 1992 for 2-year-olds and older cattle, and May 1, 1992 for calves and yearlings.

The title of all animals more than 2 years old in this competition must be shown on the registry certificater with ownership recorded by Jan. 1, 1992 as shown by the filing date on the transfer. The date of ownership on animals showing as yearlings and calves must be recorded by May 1, 1992. All ownership records will be checked by the Holstein Association of America and their decision on eligibility under this rule will be final.

PARTNERSHIP ANIMALS

Upon recommendation of the Extension Committee and management of Holstein Association of America, and in line with the rules for 4-H exhibition in the great majority of shows, all entries must stand on the association records in the individual name of the exhibitor. Senior-Junior family partnerships will not be acceptable.

QUALIFICATION FOR ENTRY

To qualify for entry in the Junior All-Pennsylvania contest, an animal must have competed in junior classes at their own county, district, state or regional show to establish their junior eligibility on their home grounds and regardless of winnings in open classes elsewhere. Junior division placings at the national shows will not qualify an animal.

CLOSING DATE

Closing date for the receipt of entries in the Junior All-Pennsylvania Awards Contest is Nov. 1. Entry is completed by submitting a suitable, professional picture of each eligible animal, together with a completed entry blank. These pictures and entry blanks should be sent to the Pennsylvania Holstein Association, 839 Benner Pike, State College, PA, 16801. Pictures sized 5-inches by 7-inches are preferred.
