

Breeding Sheep Tops Market, Sale Champions For Supreme Title

 judge who also is a York County sheep breeder.

Of the day-long Wednesday event, Witt said, "We have

extremely good sheep from top to bottom. It's outstanding quality and fun to judge such quality of sheep."

Witt was also impressed with

the good handling of lambs by the exhibitors. The showmanship classes packed the tent and were difficult for Witt to choose, but in final competition, the best showman-

ship was displayed by Lyndon Reiff in the 16-year-old and over division; Regina Landis in the 12- to 15-year-old division; and Jessica Stoltzfus, in the 11-year-old and under division.

The sheep competition was divided into three parts: market, breeding, and sale sheep. The champions of each division then competed for the Supreme Champion title, which then competes for the Supreme Champion Animal against a steer, pig, and goat.

In the market and sale sheep competition, Lyndon and Lisa Reiff of Strasburg consistently placed first for their sheep that the judge describes as having dimension, lots of muscle, and length of loin. Lyndon's heavyweight won the champion market lamb title and his lightweight captured the reserve market lamb title. In the lightweight market lamb division, Troy Bollinger took the reserve. The mediumweight champion went to Lisa and the reserve to Ryan Donough.

In the sale lamb division, Lyndon again took the championship title and his sister, Lisa, the reserve championship. Their closest competitors were Jessica Stoltzfus, who showed the lightweight champion; Carrie Groff, who showed the reserve lightweight; Melissa Becker, who showed the champion mediumweight, and Tracy Bollinger, with the reserve mediumweight.

Championships in the breed divisions went to the following: Cheviot champion and reserve, Keith Bollinger; Dorset champion and reserve, Jessica Stoltzfus. Hampshire champion Wendall Landis, reserve, Regina Landis. Shropshire champion and reserve, Lori Hamish. Southdown champion Greg Erb; reserve Mark Tracy. Suffolk champion Ryan Tracy; reserve, Jeff Bollinger. Oxford champion Katye Allen; reserve, Kerra Allen. Columbia champion and reserve, Rebecca Vogt. Tunis champion and reserve, Jill Hoffines.

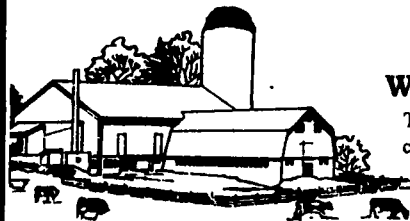
