Compared with last week: Steers of all weights and heifers over 700 lbs. unevenly steady to \$2.00 lower. Heifers under 700 lbs. steady. Good portion of downturn noted on Brahma cross. Demand uneven; moderate to good for English and exotic cross, fair for Brahma cross. Weigh conditions simialr to last week, average to full. Flesh condition also uneven with increase in moderately fleshy cattle noted; however majority of feeders still on the thinner side with some showing signs of recent weight loss. Gains for yearlings on lush pastures have been a bit disappointing this summer grazing season. Abundant moisture has kept grass too washy for optimum gains. Slaughter cows \$1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady. Cow and bull demand good; packer and country buyers both taking about 50 percent. Receipts this week 9,650; last week 11,906; last year 10,853. 




